<b>New to Industry OR Existing Worker</b>	<p><b>This course has been designed to meet the competencies required to apply for a Pest Management Licence</b> (Please check with your state's licensing authority for specific accreditation required)</p> <p><b>By completing this course learners will build knowledge and skills to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify and manage General Urban Pests</li> <li>• Create management plans and treatments with and without applying pesticides</li> <li>• Complete applications using appropriate equipment</li> <li>• Maintain required equipment and vehicle including safe storage of pesticides</li> </ul>
<b>Flexible Learning</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face to Face</li> <li>• Correspondence</li> <li>• Workplace</li> <li>• Blended</li> </ul>	<p><b>Flexible Learning</b> The course is self-paced and will require access to a digital device with camera e.g. Phone, laptop, tablet or iPad.</p> <p><b>Option 1: Face to Face</b> Complete all workshops at MPL Training Centre. Includes: 5-Day Theory Workshop, 3-Day Practical Experience Workshop and 2-Day Assessment (*10 days face to face training. Dates dependant on Workshop availability)</p> <p><b>Option 2: Correspondence</b> Units are completed by Correspondence self-paced learning. Practical requirements must be completed under the supervision of a licensed Pest Management Technician in the workplace as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to 10 sites to demonstrate General Pest practical requirements</li> <li>• Assessment includes video submission</li> <li>• MPL to assess Workplace Supervisor Declaration prior to commencing practical</li> </ul> <p><b>Option 3: Blended</b> A combination of Face to Face, Workplace, Correspondence and on-site with MPL.</p>
